UPGRADE OF PUBLIC TOILETS IN AGEGE LOCAL GOVERNMENT,
LAGOS STATE**

Bread of Life Development Foundation is a Lagos-based non-government faith-based organization promoting programmes, policies, and projects for the delivery of safe and inclusive water, sanitation, and hygiene (WASH) services to marginalized and blighted communities.

Bread of Life is implementing ‘WoleWoles in Action Against Cholera (WAC) project’ designed to combat the spread of cholera in Agege LGA, Lagos State under the Lagos Urban Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene (LUWASH) Activity

LUWASH is financed by the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) and implemented by SAI Associates Ltd/GTE (an Associated Company of SAI Associate International Inc). The implementation period is November 1, 2024, and October 31, 2025.

This EOI is for upgrade of existing 17 public toilets in Agege LGA through minor repairs of the water supply and sanitation systems to improve the functionality of the facilities. Additionally, it involves the supply of hygiene kits to the facilities.

No construction or structural works is involved.

Bread of Life invites Expression of Interest from firms interested in carrying out the assignment. A Request for Quotations (RFQ) will subsequently be issued to shortlisted firms.
